

Curriculum Areas and Subjects Mostly the children will learn these subjects on their own. The knowledge and skills they learn can be transferred between subjects.

Literacy and Languages

We will practise our talking and listening skills through group work and talking partners. We will be remembering to adjust the volume of our voice to suit our audience and to speak clearly.

P1 - Letter sounds continue. We will also be learning tricky words (Block 1/2/3) each week. We will be trying to use full stop and capital letters in all our written work

P2 - We will continue to learn tricky words and will try to make sure our writing has correct punctuation, interesting openers and connectives.

In our reading we will be looking at punctuation, the use of expression and continuing to develop our decoding skills (sounding out words, seeing patterns in words and remembering our new sounds).

French - We are learning basic classroom instructions such as "tidy up", sit down" etc. We are also learning the names of classroom items such as book, ruler, rubber etc.

Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be focusing on resilience and moving on. We will be learning that everyone experiences change, loss in their lives and finding out some different strategies and skills to support ourselves in challenging times. We will also be learning how to give appropriate support to others. Our school focus will be to make good choices and promote a healthy lifestyle.

Numeracy and Maths

Learning the language of position and movement, such as front /behind /under /beside etc. Identify left and right correctly.

Understand the language of turns - whole turn, half turn, quarter turn etc

P1 - We will be working with numbers 1-30 and beginning to look at division by sharing items into groups.

P2 -Working with arrays and discussing how these can help us to add up larger groups of items by counting the rows and columns. We continue to develop our strategies for solving maths problems

In **ICT** we are learning how to access, retrieve and use information. We will also be looking at different media we can use to take photographs

Expressive Arts

In **art** the children will experiment with collage using different types of materials.

In **drama** we will continue to use movements, gestures and facial expressions to add detail and emotion to our scenes. We will practise giving feedback to others to help them improve.

In **music** we are working from the Charanga music programme and this term the activities include learning about improvisation, The focus will be on nursery rhymes and we will also be having an opportunity to play different instruments.

Interdisciplinary Learning

During the term some of our learning will come from more than one subject. Our topics this term are 'Germs and 'Maps". We will be starting with the Germs topic which will run for approx. 5 weeks. Our Maps topic will run for the remainder of the term.

The key areas we will explore in these topics are:

1. Identify what germs are and how they spread
2. List ways to prevent the spread of germs
3. Write instructions for how to wash our hands
4. Identify significant landmarks in our local areas
5. Explore and discover local environment
6. Draw and use simple maps
7. Give directions to landmarks from school gate

Our learning activities will include:

- Naming and identifying landmarks in the Roseburn area
- Draw and use simple maps
- Create a set of directions from the school gate to one of the landmarks
- Discuss how germs can make us ill
- Germs experiment using glitter as the germs and try to wash it all off
