You could run a car down a ramp and slow it down by putting different materials on the ramp.</li> </ul> | <b>ICT</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a story character on any drawing app. Think of words you could use to describe your character's appearance and personality.</li> <li>Create a setting for a story on any drawing app. This could be a house, a cave, a forest, a room, the moon.
