Children will receive new **spelling** words each **Monday** and are to practise these at home as part of their Home Learning. Their **Home Learning jotters**, therefore, are to be brought into school on **Mondays and Fridays**.

Reading

Reading home learning should be recorded in their Reading Records at the back of their home learning books. Please check and sign their records regularly.

Belongings

Please ensure all belongings are named including water bottles and packed lunches (which should be taken home daily).

Trips

Information about school trips is shared prior to the event and is payable by parentpay. We do need parent support at our trips so if you can help please let the teacher know.

Wildlife Rangers

We will be going on a number of wildlife ranger outings in order to achieve our John Muir award at the end of primary 5 and these usually take place on the Water of Leith. Your child will require warm clothes with a waterproof jacket and wellies or waterproof

shoes, a snack and water. These outings are due to commence in September and we will advise you of these dates prior to the time. On these days please ensure your child is dropped off on time as we leave the school for 9.00am sharp, returning to school for lunch time.
