This home learning grid will last for 3 weeks and needs to be completed by Friday 31 January 2020.

A reminder about spelling - The children will be tested on the sound/spelling rule for the week and then highlight and learn any words they got wrong in the test for homework. If they get all the words right then they choose other words from the list that have the same spelling rule/sound. The Fry's Common Words will also be tested and learned. They will learn 6 words that link to the spelling rule and 2 words from the common words list each week. These will be written in back of home learning jotter.

Our work will include learning about the different types of data display (Venn, Carroll diagrams etc) and the use of simple labels and scale</div> <div>At home...</div> <div><div>- Try some of the data handling games on Topmarks.</div><div>- Discuss with an adult about all the different types of data displays they have seen (line/bar graph, pie chart) and what they were used for.</div><div>- Make some displays using data from your family.</div></div>	<div>Literacy</div> <div>In School...</div> <div>Our writing focus this term will be on personal writing.
