The Alphablocks have been a firm favourite in P1 since the start of the year.

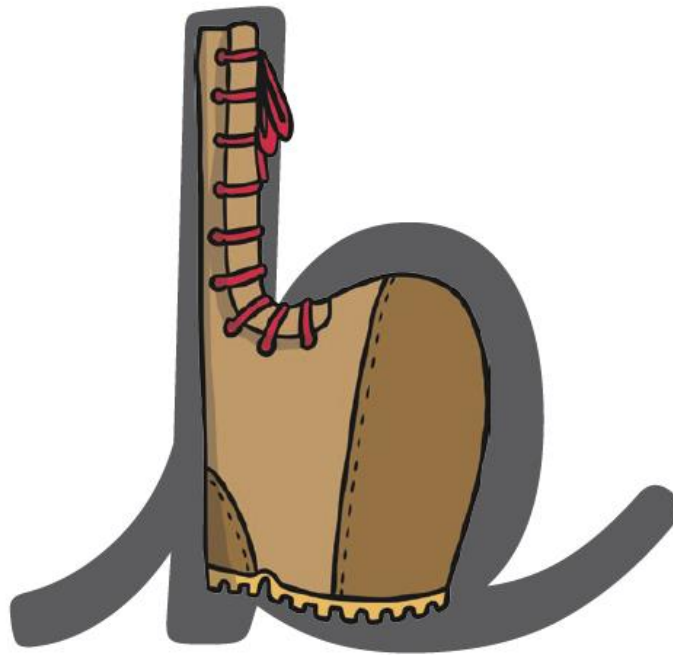
