Item	Curricular Area	Activities
1.	Maths and Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shape and measurement workbook• Money and fractions workbook• Continue with numbers to 100/20/10 workbook• Counting Skills activity sheet• Problem solving activity booklet• Sumdog and Topmarks games• Practice telling the time on digital and analogue clocks at home. Use hundred square and number line to support learning.
2.	Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spelling-See spelling words for next 3 weeks• Tricky words-copy of a 100 block of tricky words with suggested activities-Choose 5 words to learn weekly• Cursive handwriting• Reading and enjoying stories• Copy of Model Text, with highlighted key words.
3.	Topic: Food from Around the World	<p>This term we have started learning about foods from around the world.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Research where your food has come from.• Research how far your food has had to travel to get to your plate.• Find a recipe from a different country and make it with an adult. Take a picture of your final dish.
4.	HWB	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Focus on keeping as active as possible – practice your gymnastic balances and shapes.• Cosmic yoga on youtube• Take a walk with your family – how many signs of Spring can you spot?
5.	Diary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Try to keep a 'diary' in jotter. This can be drawings, pictures, writing.
