Item	Curricular Area	Activities
1.	Maths and Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths textbook• Workbook activities to revise symmetry and data handling.• Problem solving maths booklet• Number:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s etc- Build numbers using lego to represent tens and ones- Rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and 100- Use number lines to add and subtract 2 or 3 digit numbers- Find the missing number in sums eg. $47 + ? = 87$• Use Sumdog log in
2.	Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spelling<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Use the sound chart to continue practising the different sounds and which patterns make each sound- Use different colours of bricks to represent vowels and consonants. Join two letters that make one sound together, like we have in class.• Tricky words• Cursive handwriting• Reading and enjoying stories, poems, comics, blogs etc.• Comprehension booklets• Blooms buttons to discuss different texts.
3.	Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Select one of the climate zones – polar, cold, temperate, dry and tropical. Use books or the internet to find out how living things adapt in this climate zone.• Draw six symbols of Spring, e.g. lambs or daffodils. Use these to create an abstract design – like when we did the electricity chalk pictures or the weather designs on your art folder!

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a playscript of your own including interesting settings and characters. Make puppets and a backdrop and put on a show for your family!
4.	HWB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remember to do some fun things while you are off school. Some ideas include playing a game or going outside, • Cosmic Yoga – available on Youtube • Keep a note of some of the positive things that are happening in the world. For example, Venice canals are running clear.
5.	Diary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Try to keep a 'diary' in jotter. This can be drawings, pictures or writing.
