
Spelling Stations (Adjusting for home)

Cube Station

You can use cubes/Lego pieces/sweets/objects/paper to lay out the sounds you hear. If you don't have any of these items, not a problem! Be creative!



Remember

- Vowels: a, e, i, o, u
- If you have two letters that make the same sound then both cubes/lego pieces/objects/paper join or placed close together in some way.
- Dot and dash the word (dots: one sound dash: two letters that make one sound)
- Vowels and Consonants are two different colours.

Finding words with the spelling rule in books or any text.




Creative Patterns
