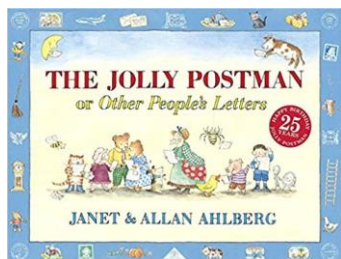


Literacy

This week our task is to think about letter writing. There are lots of different reasons we might write a letter or note to someone. Can you think of any?

This week's writing task is to write a letter to your teacher, telling them about something you enjoyed during your break.

A basic structure to use would be:

1. Start by saying who the letter is to - with 'To...' or 'Dear...'
2. Give some information
3. Ask a question
4. End by saying who the letter is from – perhaps with 'From...'
5. If you have space, draw a picture to illustrate your letter. Remember to add lots of detail.
