

Numeracy

In P1, we always start our number lessons with some counting songs. Here is a fun song we use regularly in class:

1. Count 10-100

Maths: Money

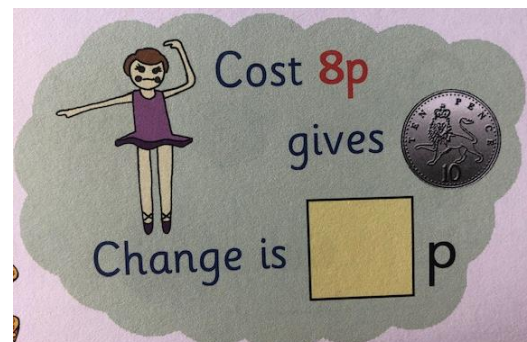
- I can apply addition and subtractions skills to pay the exact value for items

4. How much change after buying each toy?

It might help to lay out the question in a similar way to this picture on your whiteboards.

If needed, please use 1p coins or counters to support, e.g:

- Ask your child to set out ten 1p coins on top of the 10p coin (for 10p)
- Ask your child to move 8 coins (buying a doll costing 8p) away into another group
- Ask your child, "how much is left?"



- A car costs **6p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A drum costs **5p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A bus costs **4p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A helicopter costs **3p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A teddy costs **1p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A clown costs **7p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?
- A bicycle costs **2p** and I give a **10p** coin. What is my change?

5. Check your change from 10p

It is also easy to do practically with your child. Use your whiteboard to set out the questions like the image below. Ask your child if you have the correct or incorrect change.
