

## Numeracy

In P1, we always start our number lessons with some counting songs. Here is a fun song we use regularly in class:

## Maths: Money

- I can pay for an item using the correct coin
- I can apply addition skills to pay the exact value for items

### 3. Use your coins to show the different ways you can make 10p/20p:

**More ways to make 10p**  
Click on each car to see!



$5p + 5p = 10p$

$5p + 1p + 1p + 1p + 1p + 1p = 10p$

$2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p = 10p$

Can you find any more ways to make 10p?

**Ways to make 20p**  
There are a great many ways to make 20p. Here are just a few.  
Click on each football to see!



$10p + 10p = 20p$

$5p + 5p + 5p + 5p = 20p$

$2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p + 2p = 20p$

### 4. Money to 20p: How much money does each toy cost?

\*Please feel free to adapt the coins for each toy to suit you and your child.

\*There is an opportunity with some of the suggested amounts for your child to practise counting in 2s and 5s

Ball	10p, 2p
Doll	10p, 5p
Teddy bear	10p, 2p, 1p
Drum	10p, 5p, 1p
Helicopter	5p, 5p, 2p, 2p, 1p
Car	10p, 5p, 2p, 1p
Puppet	5p, 5p, 5p, 2p, 1p, 1p
Bike	10p, 5p, 2p, 1p, 1p, 1p

1. Lay out the coins, e.g. a 10p coin and a 2p coin
2. Ask, "How much does the ball cost?"
3. If child needs, please use the counters included in your home learning pack to support (we do this all the time in class!)- Ask your child to set out the right number of counters for each amount in two separate groups and then ask your child, "How much money altogether?" (child then counts the two groups of counters altogether).
