

## Numeracy

In P1, we always start our number lessons with some counting songs. Here is a fun song we use regularly in class:

### 1. The Counting by Fives Song:

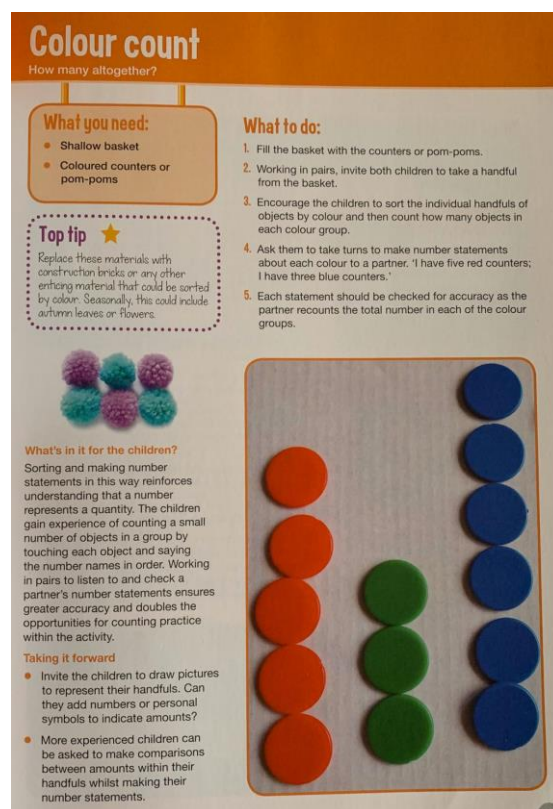

\*Continue practising other songs suggested in previous documents.

### 2. Choose one task from the 'P1 Numeracy Home Learning Ideas' sheet (in your home learning pack) to practise your number work

### 3. Colour count- How many altogether?

- Fill a basket with coloured counters or pom-poms
- Invite the child to take a handful from the basket
- Encourage the child to sort the individual handfuls or objects by colour and then count how many objects in each colour group
- Take turns to make a number statement about each colour to your partner, "*I have five red counters. I have three blue counters*".
- Each statement should be checked for accuracy



## Maths: Money

- I can pay for an item using the correct coin
- I can apply addition skills to pay the exact value for items

### 4. Money to 20p: How much is in each piggy-bank?

\*Please feel free to adapt the coins for each toy to suit you and your child.

\*There is an opportunity with some of the suggested amounts for your child to practise counting in 2s and 5s

Piggy Bank 1	10p, 5p, 1p
Piggy Bank 2	5p, 5p, 5p
Piggy Bank 3	5p, 5p, 5p, 1p
Piggy Bank 4	10p, 2p, 1p

Piggy Bank 5	5p, 5p, 5p, 2p, 2p, 1p
Piggy Bank 6	5p, 5p, 2p, 2p
Piggy Bank 7	10p, 5p, 1p, 1p, 1p
Piggy Bank 8	5p, 5p, 5p, 2p

1. Use a piggy-bank/box or draw a piggy-bank on a bit of paper/whiteboard (ask your child to do this...takes 2 seconds!)



2. Put the coins inside the piggy-bank, e.g. a 10p coin, a 2p coin, a 1p coin
3. Ask, "How much is inside the piggy-bank?"
4. Again, if child needs, please use the counters included in your home learning pack to support (we do this all the time in class!)- Ask your child to set out the right number of counters for each amount in two separate groups and then ask your child, "How much money altogether?" (child then counts the two groups of counters altogether).
