We will focus on two different graphemes (ways of writing down the sound) – ee and ea.</p> <p>Our tricky words for the week are: so and very.</p> <p>In handwriting, we will practise the letter – k.</p>	<p>Literacy: Reading Intended learning: you will be able to spot the ee grapheme in these online books:</p> <p>Leek Hotpot – https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/digital_books/1319.html</p> <p>A Map in the Attic – https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/29260.html</p>
<p>Literacy: Writing Intended learning: We will be having a go at writing a letter.</p> <p>Letters come in all sorts of different shapes and sizes. Try making your own binoculars out of junk, e.g. use 2 toilet roll tubes</p>	<p>Modern Language: French Intended learning: We are learning to say the names of the colours in French.</p> <p>Try this 'Rainbow Song': https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WZWN2Uragvc</p>	<p>Health & Wellbeing Intended learning: I know that change is a necessary part of life. Change can be positive and negative.</p> <p>This term we are learning how to 'Expect the Unexpected'.</p> <p>Things must come to an end and then we move on. Can you reflect on your first year of school and what you have learned? Perhaps you could put together some 'Top Tips' to welcome the new P1 children, telling them about what to expect in P1.</p>
