Expressive Arts

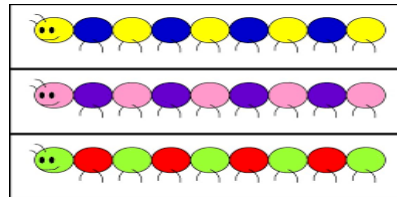
Enjoy singing along with Go Noodle
