### Vincent van Gogh – ‘Wheat Fields at Auvers Under Clouded Sky’ 1890



1. **This is a landscape** – an area of land that you can see.
  - a. How do you think it was made? What did the artist use?
  - b. What can you see in the picture? Find 5 different things.
  - c. What is the weather like? How do you know?
2. Use this image as an idea for **creating your own ‘countryside’ landscape**. It should include sky, hills and fields but you can add trees, buildings, animals etc .
  - a. Decide which **media** you will use – pencil, pen, paint, pastels – perhaps a mixture?
  - b. **Draw a sketch first**, showing the **main lines** in the picture.
  - c. You could colour the fields or fill them with different **lines and patterns**.
