It has been wonderful to welcome everyone back into the school after the closure and the children are settling in well. We have been working hard on literacy and numeracy already and we have been working on our class room charters and expectations for the year.

Home Learning - Reading, Spelling and Maths

The first home learning grid will be sent home on the 7th September. As part of their non-negotiable home learning, children will be expected to read for at least twenty minutes each night. Reading can be fiction or non-fiction although we would like a balance of different texts. Children will be encouraged to share what they have read with others. Spelling words will also be issued every week and children should be encouraged to learn these and use them in context wherever possible. Your child is registered with Sumdog and should work on-line on the Sumdog challenges set for them each week which are based on their Maths learning in school.

Belongings

Please ensure you name all clothing and belongings, including water bottles and packed lunchboxes. Water bottles and packed lunchboxes should be brought home daily and washed thoroughly.

Healthy snacks and water

As we are promoting healthy eating in our school, please note that children should bring fruit or healthy snacks and only have water in their water bottles.
