Dear Parent or Carer,

Welcome back to Roseburn Primary.

We have had a great start to P7. We are looking forward to the school year ahead. This year might look slightly different due to the Scottish Government COVID-19 guidance. The Home Learning Grid will be shared monthly. Children will receive their first grid w/b 7<sup>th</sup> September. Non-negotiable activities support learning in class and are indicated with a star, while others are optional learning opportunities linked to our learning in class.

Children will receive new spelling words each Monday and are to practise these at home as part of their Home Learning. Their Home Learning jotters, therefore, are to be brought into school on Mondays and Fridays.
