Dear Parent or Carer,

Welcome back to Roseburn Primary.

We have had a great start to P7. We are looking forward to the school year ahead. This year might look slightly different due to the Scottish Government COVID-19 guidance. The P7 team are working hard, to ensure the children have their P7 opportunities, special activities and relevant experiences throughout their final year; we have just had to be more creative.

As a class, we have been discussing ways which we can use technology to enhance the pupils learning and facilitate the roles and responsibilities that go with being a P7 pupil. Alongside this, there are plans for the pupils to communicate with their buddies via teams, whilst it is not possible to meet face to face.

The class have already made a great start with their work, with a key focus being on literacy, numeracy and health and well-being. Over the next few weeks the P7s will be applying for various responsibilities, such as House Captain, and taking advantage of the learning opportunities presented to them.

Equipment

It is important they are prepared for being outside during break times, lunchtimes and our outdoor learning session which takes place for half an hour each day. We are trying to integrate as much outdoor time as possible to encourage healthy habits.

Home Learning

The Home Learning Grid will be shared monthly. Children will receive their first grid w/b 7th September. Non-negotiable activities support learning in class and are indicated with a star, while others are optional learning opportunities linked to our learning in class.

Children will receive new spelling words each Monday and are to practise these at home as part of their Home Learning. Their Home Learning jotters, therefore, are to be brought into school on Mondays and Fridays.
