Numeracy & Maths

In school...

Our focus for March will be multiplication and division skills. We will be using our times table skills to see how these link to division. We will be developing our fluency with times tables (being able to count forwards and backwards quickly in 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's etc). We will also be learning how to divide and multiply by 10 and 100
