Dear P4 Parent or Carer,

Welcome back to Roseburn Primary. It has been so lovely to welcome back the pupils into P4 and after a great start, we are looking forward to the school year ahead.

## Clothing and belongings.

Please can you ensure that children come to school with weather-appropriate clothing each day, as break and lunchtimes will take place outdoors as much as possible. Please also make sure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled as this helps to return lost property to the correct owners. Water bottles, snack and lunch boxes should also be clearly labelled and taken home daily.

## Home Learning

The Home Learning Grid will be shared every four weeks on Teams. Children will receive their first grid **w/b 1<sup>st</sup> September**. Non-negotiable activities support learning in class and are indicated with a star. The other activities are optional and are further learning opportunities which are linked to our learning in class.

Children will receive new **spelling** words each **Monday** and are to practise these at home as part of their Home Learning. Their **Home Learning jotters** are therefore to be brought into school on **Mondays and Fridays**.

## Reading

In primary 4, we will no longer be sending home reading books for the pupils. Instead, the pupils will bring home one or two library books of their choice. These books can be taken home but should be brought into school every day and can be changed during our library slot on a Monday.

Pupils can sign into a system called Accelerated Reading where they can complete quizzes on any completed books. These quizzes are designed to test their understanding.
