

Roseburn Primary School Welcome Letter Primary 7 Session 2023-24



Dear p7 Parent or Carer,

Welcome back to Roseburn Primary. We hope you have all had a wonderful summer and are looking forward to the school year ahead. We have had a great start to P7 and it has been wonderful getting to spend time with the class again and getting to know the pupils who have joined us since P2.

Mr Carson will be the class teacher Monday to Friday and take the class for PE lessons on a Tuesday and Digital Technologies on a Wednesday. Ms Cunningham will cover Mr Carson's non-contact time on a Wednesday teaching Music and RME as well as going to the library. Mrs Denvir will teach the class Art & German on Thursdays and Mrs Thirgood will take our Wednesday PE session and Food Technologies/Science on a Tuesday. This way the children will benefit from the expertise of each teacher and will become used to following a timetable and curriculum similar to what they will experience at high school. We will work as a P7 year group throughout the year and have lots to look forward to, including running for House Captains and school jobs, Lagganlia, working with P1 buddies and high school transition events.

As a P6 & 7 staff team we have already met to plan the timetable together to ensure all areas of the curriculum are covered and are using the progressive plans for P7. We hope all activities will engage learners and allow them to take greater responsibility for their learning. Further information will be provided and questions can be answered at the 'Meet The Teacher' event on Wednesday 6th September 4-5pm where you will have an opportunity to meet the team.

Equipment

P7 will have PE on a **Tuesday** and **Wednesday**. Please ensure they have a bag with shorts, leggings or joggers, t-shirt (in house colours if possible) and indoor gym shoes/ trainers in school. There may be other occasions where outside providers offer taster sports sessions like rugby, American Football on other days so it is useful to always have kit available.

iPads should be brought fully charged each day.

Please ensure your child comes to school every day with a waterproof coat, as it is important, they are appropriately clothed for break times, lunchtimes, and our outdoor learning activities. If appropriate sun cream and a hat should be brought on sunny days.

Any medication should be handed in to the school office with the necessary form.

Please ensure all belongings brought to school are named clearly including water bottles and packed lunch boxes (which should be taken home daily).

Home Learning

The Home Learning Grid will be shared monthly in class and on TEAMS. If a paper copy is required please ask. Children will receive their first grid for w/b 4th September. Non-negotiable activities support learning in class and include reading, spelling and maths, while others are optional learning opportunities linked to our learning in class. Home Learning will be shared on a Friday so jotters should be brought on this day, as well as using our class team to share the learning.
