Digital Schools Award

- Achieved our Digital Schools Scotland Award on 27 Sep 2024. Very positive feedback in the validation report.
- Roseburn Primary School is now listed and appears as a Digital School on Digital Schools Scotland Website.
- Recommendations:
- Roseburn Primary School's self-evaluation gives a comprehensive overview of the digital
 work of the school over the last few years. This was supported by a wide range of
 documentary evidence as well as a Sway presentation containing photographs, video,
 screen shots and web links of digital learning in action in Roseburn Primary School
- The validation session was well organised and consisted of discussions with the head teacher, digital leader, the tech team, five class teachers and six groups of learners from across the school.
- I recommend that Roseburn Primary School receive the Digital Schools Award in recognition
 of their use of digital technologies. This school is well placed to support other settings on their
 digital journey. I recommend this school for the role of mentor school.
