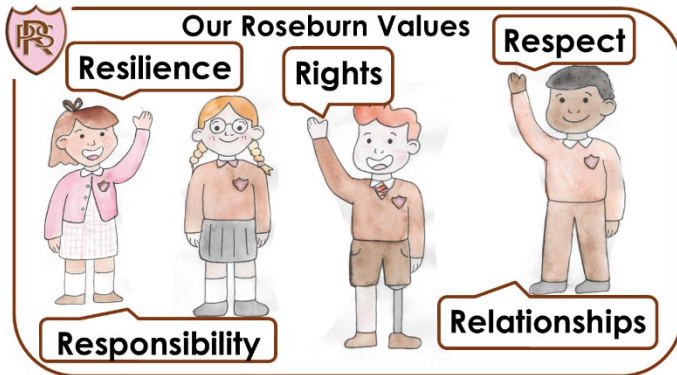

We will

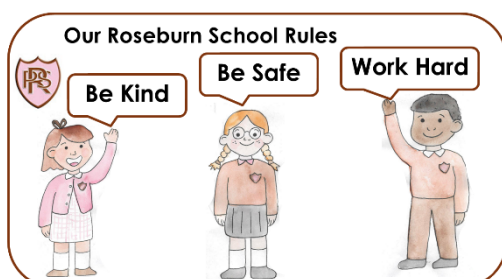
Because **we want to**

- take responsibility for ourselves, for our actions and for making things right, in a restorative conversation
- accept that we may need help from someone else to do this (child, adult or parent)
- accept that there may be consequences (beyond a restorative conversation) however these
- will always be specific to the situation and the individual needs of everyone involved
