

## Literacy

*In Literacy the children will be....*

- Practicing segmenting and blending to read and write simple CVC words
- Recognizing and writing tricky/common words.
- Becoming familiar with the concept of a sentence and basic punctuation.
- Writing letters to Santa, making Christmas cards and addressing envelopes.
- Creating class stories and a P1 nativity script.

## Numeracy and Maths

*In Numeracy the children will be ....*

- Counting forwards and backwards (to 20 and beyond)
- Continuing to recognise numbers in the environment
- Estimation and counting groups of items with 1:1 correspondence.
- Exploring the concept of more and less
- Number bonds to 5 (e.g.:  $2+3=5$ ,  $1+4=5$ )
- Developing an awareness of how money is used and begin to recognise and use a range of coin
- **Maths** according to class interests – time, shape, graphs and charts, measurement, and fractions

## Wider Curriculum Subjects

- Religious and Moral Education: Develop awareness of the importance of celebrations, festivals and customs in religious people's lives
- Music & Movement: Singing and playing along to music of different styles and cultures. Explore the use of their voice, musical instruments and music technology to discover and enjoy playing with sound and rhythm
- PE: The children will be focusing on ball skills, invasion games, travelling safely and navigating obstacles.
