

Literacy

Our writing focus for the beginning of the month is Imaginative Writing, focusing on the beginning, middle and end parts of a story.

- I can create my own stories, with recognisable features of genre.
- I can create interesting characters showing their feelings and actions and physical description

We will also continue to focus on:

Handwriting: We continuing to learn cursive formation.

Grammar: Capital Letters

Spelling: vowel digraphs (these will be highlighted in homework jotters each week)

Reading: to develop fluency and expression.

Numeracy and Maths

Subtraction

- I can develop my understanding of related facts within 10, e.g. $5+2=7$ / $7-2=5$
- I can count back in ones to solve a subtraction calculation within 20, then extend 0-100
- I can solve missing number calculations, e.g. $8 - ? = 5$
- I am developing my knowledge of the **find the difference strategy** within 10, e.g. $7 - 6 =$ (starting on 6...+ 1 = 7)

Money

- I can identify, name and order all coins and notes up to £10
- I can explore the different ways to make the same total up to 20p.
- Given a set number of coins, I can count the total (within 20p)
- I can add the cost of two items together to find the total within 20p
- I can calculate change within 20p

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- French: Through games and use of ICT we will learn the days of the week, months of the year and the weather
- Religious and Moral Education:
I can develop an awareness of the ways in which Christians celebrate at different times of year and can relate this to my own life and community
- Music: Youth Music Initiative (every Thursday for 6 weeks)
- PE: The children will be focusing on fitness and central net games.
