

Literacy

Our writing focus this term will be on poetry writing linked to Remembrance Day, newspaper reports and discursive writing & research skills.

Handwriting: We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins, as outlined in weekly overview.

Grammar: Parts of speech revision, sentence structures (clauses & conjunctions) and direct speech.

Spelling: Challenge words which do not follow a regular pattern using games and resources on 'Spelling Shed'

Reading: Reading groups – with a focus on inference skills and discussing themes in writing.

Numeracy and Maths

Our numeracy focus will be on fractions, decimals and percentages and money.

This will include learning about:

- Simplifying and finding equivalent fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Converting between mixed and improper fractions
- Converting between fractions & decimal numbers
- Calculations involving decimals.
- Understanding percentages
- Addition & Subtraction of money
- Real life money skills, such as budgeting and understanding terms such as credit, debit, loans and interest.

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- French: through games and use of ICT we will learn about how to talk about where you live, adjectives and directions.
- German: Revise numbers to 100, animals and Christmas traditions.
- Religious and Moral Education: Islam
- PE: Fitness & Central Net Games.
- Art: Art linked to Remembrance & World War 2.
