

## Literacy

- **Writing:** We will be focusing on Scots Language for the first part of the term. We will then be moving on to learning skills to write poetry.
- **Handwriting:** We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins.
- **Grammar:** Focusing on the use of pronouns, connectives/conjunctions and developing the use of paragraphs in our work
- **Spelling:** Continuing to work on words with a different suffix (such as -tion, -cian etc) plus challenge words
- **Reading:** Working on skimming and scanning, note taking and identifying key parts of a piece of text.

## Numeracy and Maths

- We will be focusing on Information handling, measurement and decimals/fractions/percentages.
- Find fractions of an amount
- Express fractions in simplest form
- Make links between fractions, decimals and percentages
- Convert between common units of measurement
- Make accurate estimates of area, mass, length and capacity
- Read a variety of scales
- Devise ways of collecting data suitable to a task
- Collect, and display data in a variety of ways (graphs, charts, tables etc)
- Draw conclusions from data
- Use correct mathematical language

## Wider Curriculum Subjects

- **French:** Naming body parts and describing ourselves
- **German:** Naming classroom items and talking about members of our family
- **Expressive arts** – Continue working through the Charanga programme for music and learning some Scottish country dances.
- **Technologies:** We will be investigating textiles by learning about natural and man-made fibres.
