

Literacy

Our writing focus this term will be on Scots Language, looking at poems and traditional stories that are written in Scots. We will also look at imaginative writing, with a focus on characterisation.

Handwriting: We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins, as outlined in weekly overview.

Grammar: Revision of different types of word, sentence structures, paragraphs and punctuation, including direct speech, commas and semi-colons.

Spelling: Challenge words which do not follow a regular pattern using games and resources on 'Spelling Shed'

Reading: Reading groups – with a focus on inference skills and discussing themes in writing.

Numeracy and Maths

Our numeracy focus will be on measure, time and expression & equations. This will include

- Reading and using scales and other measuring tools accurately.
- Converting between different metric units of measure for length, mass and volume.
- Area and perimeter of squares & rectangles.
- Reading analogue and digital clocks
- 12- and 24-hour time.
- Calculating durations and timing events/activities.
- Calculating distance/speed/time
- Following schedules and timetables.
- Using letters and symbols to represent unknown numbers in a sum.

- German: Hobbies & Interests, days of the week.
- Art: Scottish Artists
- Science: Renewable Energy & Electrical Circuits.
- Technology: Coding & Cyber Resilience.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Natural Disasters

This term, our class will be exploring natural disasters in Social Studies. Pupils will learn what natural disasters are, such as floods, earthquakes, volcanoes, and hurricanes, and discuss why they happen. We'll watch short clips, create timelines of events, and investigate how the environment influences these disasters. Children will research how communities prepare for and recover from events like Hurricane Katrina, and how buildings can be designed to withstand earthquakes. Through group posters, reports, and practical experiment, pupils will develop their understanding of causes, impacts, and responses to natural disasters worldwide.
