

Literacy

Our writing focuses for this term are:

Personal account – writing to inform about personal events, using chronological order and time openers to structure the writing.

Diary Entry – writing in the role of a Roman character, using learning about Roman life.

We will also continue to focus on:

Handwriting: using cursive formation. Each week we will look at single sounds before moving on to joins.

Spelling: different weekly spelling patterns, including spelling rules for plurals.

Reading: reading for enjoyment and developing fluency and expression

Listening and Talking: presenting research for our topic and debating ideas.

Numeracy and Maths

Our Numeracy focus this term will be revising addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. We will also focus on number patterns and expressions and equations.

Our Maths topics this term are chance and uncertainty, measurement and shape, position and movement.

We will learn to:

- Understand greater than, less than and equal to using symbols.
- describe the likelihood of events occurring.
- estimate how long or heavy an object is or what amounts it holds.
- measure or weigh objects using instruments and units.
- convert units of measurement.
- understand and continue repeated number patterns.
- use appropriate language to describe position and direction.

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- French: We are learning to describe animals and will learn about French Mountains and Rivers.
- Religious and Moral Education: We are learning about the beliefs, traditions and practices of the Buddhist faith and of some non-religious groups.
- PE: We will focus on Cricket and Athletics
- Science: We are learning about simple electronic circuits.

- create maps to show where Ancient Rome was and how the empire expanded
- design and create Roman soldier's uniform
- build a model Roman road and aqueducts
- learn the basic Roman Numerals
- compare life in Roman times to life today.
