

Literacy

Writing This term we will focus on personal reflective writing, and using this to write about our memories of our time at Roseburn ahead of high school transition.

Grammar: Adjectives & Adverbs, singular and plural nouns, phrases, clauses, pronouns, direct speech & general punctuation revision.

Spelling: Challenge words which do not follow a regular pattern using games and resources on 'Spelling Shed'

Reading: Class novel, as well as reading comprehension with a focus on retrieval, inference and understanding skills.

Numeracy and Maths

Numeracy this term will look at **angles, shape, probability and patterns/sequences.**

- Understanding and describing 2D and 3D shapes, including angles, symmetry and key features.
- Using coordinates and grid references to read and create maps.
- Following and giving directions, including using angles
- Exploring transformations such as reflections and rotations and
- Learning the language of probability
- Using data to predict outcomes and discuss real-life uncertainty.
- Using fractions, decimals and percentages to describe chance.
- Identifying and extending patterns and sequences, and explaining the rules behind them

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- **French & German:** Revision of learned vocabulary.
- **Art:** Pop Art and Leaver's Dance decorations.
- **Science:** Electrical Circuits
- **Technology:** Coding: Game Design and Development (events, conditionals, loops)
