

Literacy

- **Writing:** We will be learning to select and organise relevant information from texts. We will also apply what we have learned in grammar lessons in short, creative writing tasks.
- **Handwriting:** We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins.
- **Grammar:** We will be focusing on nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs.
- **Spelling:** We will be using our phonics knowledge and spelling strategies to spell tricky or unfamiliar words.
- **Reading:** Working on fluency and expression when reading aloud and exploring a variety of different genres.

Numeracy and Maths

This term, our focus will be:

- **Numeracy:** We are focusing on place value and counting numbers within 0-1000. We will also be learning and consolidating a variety of strategies for addition and subtraction.
- **Maths:** We are exploring the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects. We are also looking at the impact that mathematics has had on our world, within the past, present and future. Lastly, we will be looking at ideas of chance and uncertainty within maths.

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- **French:** We are learning numbers from 1-31 as well as looking at dates, birthdays and other special occasions.
- **Music:** We are very lucky to be receiving choir lessons once a week where we will work with Mrs MacKinnon practice our singing.
