

Literacy

- **Writing:** We will be focusing on persuasive writing and letter writing this term. In our persuasive writing we will be learning how to engage and/or influence the reader through vocabulary and/or use of language such as rhetorical questions, emotive language etc.
- **Handwriting:** We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins. This month we are focusing on bottom joins.
- **Grammar:** Singular and plural nouns, plus collective nouns
- **Spelling:** Focusing on words endings such as -ious, -cial, -ance, -ence
- **Reading:** Working on fluency, using expression when reading aloud and exploring a variety of different genres. We will be exploring a class novel called Lions and Liars by Kate Beasley

Numeracy and Maths

This term, our focus will be:

- Reading, writing, partitioning and comparing whole numbers up to 100,000
- Rounding whole and decimal numbers and using this to estimate and check answers to problems.
- Developing counting skills by counting on in larger steps (e.g. thousands, ten-thousands) and by counting in tenths and hundredths with decimals.
- Addition & subtraction strategies, using a variety of mental and written methods.
- Number patterns, multiples and square numbers

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- French: Numbers to 100, weather forecasts, pronouncing European countries
- German : Numbers to 100, Alphabet, calendar
- Music: Linked to our topic "Europe" we will be looking at the Eurovision Song Contest and learning about European artists.
- Art: Observational drawings linked to experiences across the curriculum, for example, a view from a window, features of the built environment, pets, self etc
