

Literacy

- **Writing:** Our writing focus for the beginning of the month is persuasive and functional writing to create house captain speeches, job adverts and descriptions, job application forms and write CV's to apply for our P7 jobs.
- **Handwriting:** We are using cursive formation. Each week we will focus on different joins.
- **Grammar:** Revision of parts of speech (noun, verb, adjective, adverb, pronoun and preposition).
- **Spelling:** We will continue with our spelling progression from primary 6 and focus on challenge words and resources on 'spelling shed'.
- **Reading:** Working on fluency, using expression when reading aloud and exploring a variety of different genres. We will be exploring a class novel called Holes.

Numeracy and Maths

This term, our focus will be:

- Reading, writing, partitioning and comparing whole numbers up to 10, 000,000
- Rounding whole and decimal numbers and using this to estimate and check answers to problems.
- Developing counting skills by counting on in larger steps (e.g. thousands, ten-thousands) and by counting in tenths and hundredths with decimals.
- Addition & subtraction strategies, using a variety of mental and written methods.
- Patterns and relationships.
- Ideas of chance and uncertainty.

Wider Curriculum Subjects

- **French:** Learning to describe ourselves and our families. Describing our hobbies and interests.
- **German:** Numbers to 100, Alphabet, calendar.
- Religious and Moral Education: Buddhism, the key figures, beliefs, artefacts, birth, marriage and death ceremonies.
- **Art:** Architectural line drawings and paintings, linked to the Scottish Parliament building.
- **PE:** Possession games.
