Dear Roseburn Primary 1 Families,

We have had a super start to P1 and are looking forward to the school year ahead. The children are settling in well and are adapting to all the different and varied routines that we are learning.

Learning this year

We will send home a weekly roundup of holistic learning via the Learning Journals. You will also receive termly individual observations to spotlight your child's progress. Please ensure you can access the Learning Journals; any problems, please do let us know. You will also receive any reminders or upcoming dates for your diary.

Reading

Reading home learning will commence the week after our 'Welcome to Learning in P1' event on **Wednesday 2nd September**. Reading bags and books will be sent home from Monday to Thursday. Each day you will be expected to read some pages of the book. This information will be found inside their reading record which will also be sent home. There is a comments section inside the reading record - this is for both teacher and parent to use to record any notes about the child's reading progress that day in school or at home. Please use this section of the reading record for comments or questions to the teacher. We will start with wordless books before moving on to books with phonologically decodable text. Information about wordless books and how to read these with your child at home will be provided inside the front cover of your child's reading record.

Library Times

P1C will visit the school library on a **Thursday**.

P1P will visit the school library on a **Monday**.

PE Sessions

PE for **P1C** will be on Wednesday and Thursday

PE for **P1** will be Tuesday and Thursday.

If you have not already done so please send in your child's clearly labelled PE bag.

PE kits will be kept in the classroom and sent home at the end of each term. Their kit should consist of a pair of shorts or jogging bottoms, a t-shirt in their house colour and a pair of indoor shoes.

Buddies

This year each P1 child will have a P7 buddy. These buddies are a big support to the children and a variety of Buddy events are lined up throughout the course of P1.

Belongings

Please ensure all belongings are **named**, including water bottles and packed lunches (which should be taken home daily). A small daily healthy snack should be provided.

Outdoor Learning

In P1, learning outdoor opportunities take place in the school grounds and in our local community. They are linked to class learning, and the development of metaskills. Your child needs to bring a coat each day and wear appropriate footwear.
