Learning this year

At the beginning of each term, we will share a Termly Overview detailing the learning and teaching for the term. Any non-negotiables to support learning and teaching focuses in class will be highlighted in the Termly Overview or via Learning Journals. We actively encourage children to share any wider achievements and learning in class assemblies and HT weekly Sway.

Home learning

Please note that P2 home learning will commence Monday 31st August. We are carrying out assessments in class to help us understand your child's needs and ensure that learning is appropriately targeted and supported both at home and at school. Home Learning Jotters will be sent home Monday 31st August.

Home learning will consist of the following:

- Reading books which are sent home on a Monday and to be returned to school on Friday.
- Spelling words which focus on our sound for that week. These words should be practised at home.
- Tricky words which should be reinforced at home (this includes practising both reading and writing each tricky word).

We encourage children to share their home learning in class. Please continue to upload and share achievements, fun activities and family outings on Learning Journals.

Library Times

P2 (Mrs Hartop) will visit the library on **Thursday**

P2 (Miss Watkins) will visit the school library on a **Friday**.

PE Sessions

P2 will have PE on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**

We ask pupils bring their PE Kit with them to change into. This kit will stay in school. Their kit should consist of a pair of shorts or jogging bottoms, a t-shirt in their house colour and a pair of indoor shoes.
