Dear **Primary 6C Families**,

Welcome back to the new school year. It has been so lovely to welcome the pupils into Primary P6C and they are settling in well into their new classroom.

Learning this year

At the beginning of each term, we will share a Termly Overview detailing the learning and teaching for the term. Any non-negotiables to support learning and teaching at home will be in the Home Learning folder on Teams (children will be shown how to access this). We actively encourage children to share any wider achievements and learning on Teams, in class, at assemblies and in HT weekly Sway.

Home learning

Spelling - There will be 10 spelling words to learn each week, and these will follow a new sound/theme/pattern each week. Children will be tested on the 10 words on a Monday, and these words will be recorded at the back of their home learning jotters so they can work on them during the week.

Reading - P6 children are encouraged to "read for enjoyment" at home for approximately 20 minutes each night. They will continue to read school reading books/texts in class but will not be bringing specific books home with designated pages/chapters to read as they did in P1-4. Children are also strongly encouraged to have their own reading book in class; this may be a book from home, or one borrowed from the school library.

Maths - Maths home learning tasks will be placed in the home learning jotter and will usually take the form of a monthly calendar of activities. This can be completed daily, weekly or in whatever way works best at home.

We have an opportunity on Fridays for children to share any home learning in class, as well as any wider achievements. Children can also post any photos or updates in the sharing learning folder on our Teams.

Library Times

We will visit the school library on a **Thursday**.

PE Sessions

This term our PE will be on a **Tuesday**, and a **Wednesday**. We ask that children bring their PE Kit with them to change into. Their kit should consist of a pair of shorts or jogging bottoms, a t-shirt in their house colour and a pair of indoor shoes.

Belongings

Please ensure all belongings are named, including water bottles and packed lunches (which should be taken home daily). A small daily healthy snack should be provided.

Outdoor Learning

In P6C learning outdoor opportunities take place in the school grounds, and in our local community, and are linked to class learning, and the development of meta skills. Please ensure your child brings a coat to school each day and wears appropriate footwear.

Sharing Learning

This event will be on Thursday 3 September between 2.30-3pm. This will be an opportunity to visit your child's classroom and hear about the learning they have been doing. I hope to see you all there.
